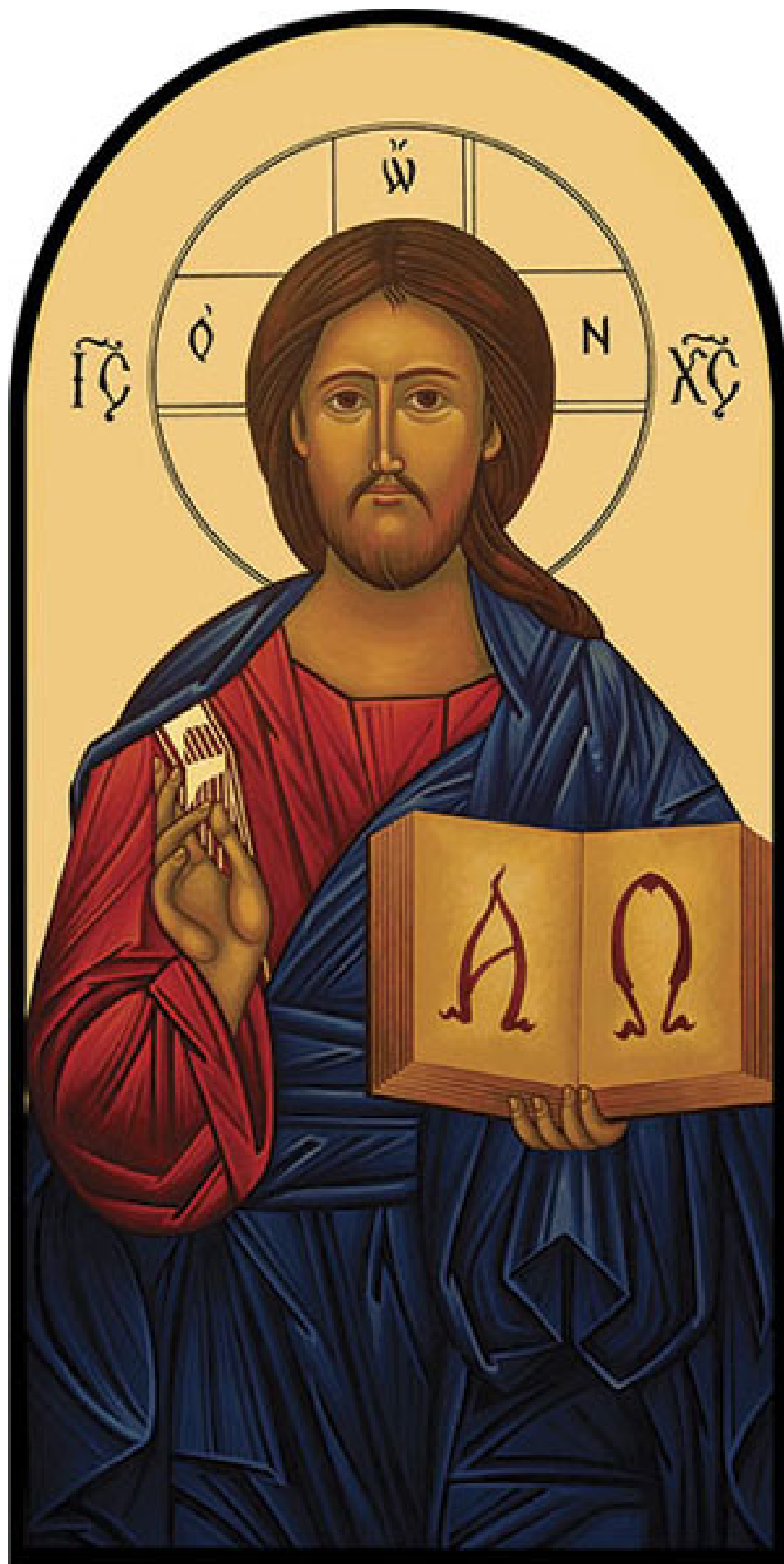

Welcome to St. Joseph of Arimathea. We are thankful that you decided to join us for worship this morning. Once you enter the sanctuary, please take time before the service to reflect and pray. Suggested prayers before worship can be found on page 833 of the Book of Common Prayer.

Children are always welcome to sit with their parents for the entire worship service. Because we know this is not always ideal, *nursery care is provided downstairs during the 10:30 service* for ages five and under and a cry room is available on the main floor. If your child does not remain with you for the whole service, they are encouraged to return for communion.
